



Adam and his team at 780 Kennels hold themselves to the highest standards. They conduct themselves in a professional and engaged manner. You can see in the way they handle their client's dogs that they have a true passion for what they do. They are efficient, and structured. The team takes having dogs in their care very seriously and implement multiple safety measures for the dog(s) and their staff.

780 Kennels offers a yearly membership program that provides a variety of services from boarding, daycare, off leash running, dog parks, and training at different levels and focuses. Membership is \$250/year but they show their support for our first responders by offering a discounted rate of \$1. Some amazing perks to their membership is 1 free kennel day per month, guaranteed reservations, 1 free ½ hr training session per month, free in-home training literature, 1 free daycare per month, and members-only private off-leash dog parks & free monthly pack walks. 780 has gone above and beyond to then also extend this offer to dog rescues. Their humane kennel design with room for any sized dog breeds all the way up to giant breed, indoor removable walls, limited dogs per room for unique needs like reactive or timid personalities, large outdoor exercise runs and multiple dog parks for long strides, and even affordable enrichment options as needed.

Another great option for rescues is they accept emergency surrenders. In the scenario a dog needs placement but no foster home is available, 780 Kennels will provide peace of mind that there is always space and offer 50% off boarding. There is never a rush to move a dog from 780 due to space. When a rescue dog is in foster or adopted, that family is able to take advantage of a \$1/year honorary membership granting all fosters / adopters with all the benefits that come along with it. This helps support fosters or adopters with the transition of their rescue dog into a new environment. They have experience and skills that allow them to work with some of the most challenging training cases.

They have helped transform one of our rescue intakes from being terrified and reactive in kennel environments who wouldn't let any humans or other dogs near him, to now sitting in his staff's laps, loving attention, and playing with some other dogs along the fence. Our rescue dog was severely underweight and now we has reached an acceptable weight. His team never backed away from the challenge and now, our boy has a chance to find his forever family.

Adam and his team have on more than one occasion assisted our rescue with meet and greets for potential adopters. They held them within controlled environments, keeping things safe and coached potential adopters through the whole meeting. Even after being involved in the rescue for many years, they were able to show us vital skills on how to read behaviors between dogs and towards humans to help us make a more informed decision when choosing the best place our rescue Danes.
